AN ACT TO ADD A NEW CHAPTER II-A TO TITLE XVII OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE TO REGULATE THE SALE OF SCRAP MATERIALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: 1 Section 1. A new Chapter II-A is added to Title XVII of 2 the Government Code to read: 3 "CHAPTER II-A 4 Scrap Dealers 5 Section 16125. Definition. As used in this Chapter, 6 the term 'scrap dealer' means any person who is licensed to 7. engage in the purchase or the sale of metal, other than 8 procious metals, or other items that are normally and 9 generally defined as scrap, second-hand items or junk. 10 Section 16126. A scrap dealer shall not purchase 11 scrap during the hours from 6:00 p.m. to 3:00 a.m. 12 Section 16127. (a) Each scrap dealer shall keep a 13 written record of each purchase of scrap, junk or other 14 second hand items. 15 (1) The record for all items except aluminum cans 16 or tin cans or small items not brought in a motor vehicle 17 shall include: 13
