




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DEDICATION OF GOVERNMENT-  
OWNED LAND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A PUBLIC CEMETERY  
IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MERIZO.

1           WHEREAS, the Merizo cemetery has practically no available  
2 land area for use by residents of Merizo and neighboring  
3 villages; and

4           WHEREAS, the residents of Merizo and adjacent villages are  
5 in dire need of a public cemetery; and

6           WHEREAS, there is adequate government-owned land contiguous  
7 to the existing Merizo cemetery; now, therefore,

8           BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

9           Section 1. The Governor of Guam shall dedicate government-  
10 owned real property not to exceed five (5) acres for the con-  
11 struction of a public cemetery in the municipality of Merizo.  
12 The government-owned real property designated for said purpose  
13 shall be contiguous to the existing Merizo cemetery. The  
14 Governor may contract for maintenance of the public cemetery  
15 with a non-profit organization provided that such services be  
16 provided the government for a nominal fee.

17           Section 2. The Governor shall negotiate for the acquisition  
18 of private land by purchase or exchange for the purpose of  
19 providing a public access to the public cemetery.
