AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE OPERATION OF THE FIRST SESSION OF THE SIXTEENTH CUAM LEGISLATURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Logislative Operations Fund to be allocated by the Committee on Rules, the sum of Three Million Nine Hundred Hinety Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety Nine Dollars (\$3,999,999) of which One Million One Hundred Sixty Three Thousand Dollars (\$1,163,000) shall be allocated to the Minority, for the operation of the First Session of the Sixteenth Guam Legislature.

Section 2. Any appropriation made to the Fifteenth Guam Legislature for use in calendar year 1980 shall continue to be available and may be expended to honor claims for payment.
