AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 1434 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE BY ADDING A NEW SUBSECTION (j) RELATIVE TO EMPOWERING THE SURUHANU TO BRING CIVIL PROCEEDINGS AND RETAIN COUNSEL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 1434 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended by adding a new Subsection (j) thereto to read as follows:

"(j) To bring civil proceedings in any appropriate court to enforce the provisions of this Chapter and to retain legal counsel to effectuate the intent of this subsection and this Chapter."
