



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

Introduced by: F. F. Blas

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AN ACT RELATIVE TO ELIMINATING AND PROHIBITING  
THE GUAM POWER AUTHORITY FROM INCLUDING IN ITS  
RATES MAKING PROCESS THE FOUR PER CENT (4%) IN  
LIEU TAX PAYMENTS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 21509(b) of the Government Code of Guam  
3 is repealed in its entirety.

4 Section 2. This Act shall become effective ninety (90)  
5 days after enactment.
