




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT TO PROVIDE DIRECT ASSISTANCE TO  
FARMERS WHO LOST CROPS DUE TO TYPHOON  
BETTY.

13 Section 2. ~~The~~ One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars  
14 (\$120,000) deappropriated in Section 1 of this Act is appropriated  
15 to the Department of Agriculture for the purpose of compensating

17 winds and rains caused by Typhoon Betty in October 1980 subject

(a) Claims to the department must be submitted within 30 calendar days after this bill is enacted into law.

(b) Any and all sums unexpended from the appropriation made herein as of June 30, 1981 shall be reverted to the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund; and

(c) The Director of Agriculture shall submit to the Speaker of the Guam Legislature a report relative to the appropriation made herein and the number of claims filed and approved, dollar value, and the sums returned to the General Fund, if any, as well as attest to all the conditions and provisions of law, or any rules and regulations provided herein.

Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
