Section 2. The One Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars

(\$120,000) deappropriated in Section 1 of this Act is appropriated
to the Department of Agriculture for the purpose of compensating
in part individuals who suffered agricultural losses from the
winds and rains caused by Typhoon Betty in October 1980 subject
to the conditions set herein:

	(a) trains to the department must be submitted within
