AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF EXPENSES OF SEVERAL AGENCIES OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM FOR THE ONE YEAR PERIOD BEGINNING JULY 1, 1981, EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE NOTED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Definitions. As used in this Act:

- (1) Personnel Services includes (a) all salaries and wages whether payable to full-time, part-time, temperary or limited employees of the government of Guam and also includes the government's contributions to the employee's insurance plans and the Retirement Fund or FICA. Payments for overtime and night differential shall be in compliance with Section 4110.4 of the Government Code.
- (b) Increments which shall be awarded to employees of the government of Guam on the basis set forth by Section 4103 of the Government Code of Guam.
- (2) Operating Expenses includes (a) the cost of travel by common carrier or by private conveyance, and per diem as provided for by Sections 6610.1, .2 and .3 and 6610.5 of the Government Code.
- (b) Services rendered or performed by firms or individuals other than expenses for personnel services.

(c) Supplies and materials which by their nature are consumable and which have a useful lifetime of less than one year or which, after usage, undergo an impairment or a material change in physical condition.

- (d) Current services or charges for rental of property or equipment, insurance premiums (not employee benefits), dues, paid subscriptions, and other fixed charges.
- (e) Equipment having a purchase price of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) or less.
- (3) Capital outlay includes (a) equipment such as loader trucks, tractors, trailers, automobiles or other vehicles, machinery, reference books, office furniture, filing cabinets, typewriters, adding and calculating machines, and other business machines which have a useful lifetime of one year or more, and other machines including but not limited to tools, implements, and instruments which may be used continuously without material change in physical condition costing not less than Five Hundred Bollars (\$500) and not more than Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000).
- (b) Repair, remodeling, or alterations of a building or replacement thereof, the replacement and renewal of the plumbing, wiring and air conditioning system, and not costing more than Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000). This does not include normal maintenance to any structure.
- (c) The construction of an entirely new building, including the materials and labor either supplied by an agency of the government of Guam or supplied by contract.

- (4) "FTE" means the equivalent of one (1) position continuously filled full-time for the period to which this act pertains and the total FTE positions may comprise any combination of part-time or full-time positions provided the maximum FTE position limit is not exceeded. The maximum limitation on the number of FTE which shall be allowed for the period to which this Act pertains is indicated by a number in parentheses () following the line item or subtotal or under the figure under the "Appropriation From" column, in which case the maximum for FTE is limited for each fund source. When a position is created for less than one (1) year, the department or agency shall indicate the termination date of the position and the time period by the date designated for filling the position and termination shall be counted and applied against the total FTE position limitation.
- (5) Where no specific limitation for expenditure of funds is made, the appropriation shall be for personnel services, operating expenses, and capital outlays.
- (6) Utilities include water, sewer service, electricity, and telephone service, including toll calls.
- (7) "Match" means direct cost sharing or in-kind General Fund support required as a condition for acceptance of federal funds.

(8). Numbered footnotes throughout this Act refer to limitations on expenditures which are explained after each section of this Act.

Section 2. Appropriation.

- (1). The sums in this section are appropriated from the General Fund and the indicated cash funds for the payment of the ordinary operating costs of several agencies of the Executive Branch of the territory of Guam for and during the year beginning July 1, 1981.
 - (a) The figures in the column headed "Item and Subtotal" are the amounts appropriated from local funds or authorized if federal funds within each line item.

 The figures in the "Total" and "Grand Total" column are for information only and are not appropriations.
 - (b) The figures in the "General Fund", "Cash Fund", and "Federal Fund" columns indicate the source of funding for the amounts indicated in the "Item and Subtotal" column.
 - (c) The figures in the "General Fund" column indicate the maximum amount that may be expended from the General Fund for the purpose shown.
 - (d) Where the letter "(M)" appears directly to
 the right of a General Fund figure, that General Fund
 appropriation is used to match a federally-supported
 program and is the maximum amount of General Fund
 money that may be expended in that program, except
 where otherwise noted. In the event that additional
 federal funds are available for the program, the General
 Fund amount noted "(N)" shall be reduced by the amount

of federal funds received in excess of the "Federal Fund" column for that program. In the event that the federal funds available are less than the amount shown in the "Federal Fund" column, the General Fund amount noted "(M)" shall be reduced proportionately. In the event that the local matching requirements are reduced, the General Fund amount notes as "(M)" shall be reduced proportionately. These provisions shall apply only to the General Fund amount which remains unexpended at the time of the change in federal requirement or funding. It is the intent of the Legislature that the General Fund and the Federal Funds amounts in this Act shall be expended in equally proportioned amounts throughout the year.

- (e) The figures in the "Federal Fund" column are anticipated federal funds and although these funds are not appropriated in this Act, they are noted for the purpose of indicating the assumption used relative to those funds in developing the basic appropriation amounts.
- (f) The Guam Legislature undertakes no obligation directly or indirectly to support or continue federal fund programs or claims where no direct or indirect government of Guam contribution is required. Furthermore, the Guam Legislature undertakes no obligation for costs incurred by or claimed against non-appropriated federally funded programs.

- made in this Act shall expend local monies in anticipation of reimbursement from any federal grant, whether that grant partially or wholly funds the agency's programs, unless that program or grant is included in this Act. For those programs which are wholly funded by federal funds, and whose sums are indicated herein, advance use of local monies shall not exceed forty percent (40%) of that total grant identified herein at any point in time.
- (h) No money appropriated in this Act shall knowingly be paid to any organization, public firm, person, agency, or club which places restrictions on employment or membership based on sex, race, age, marital status, creed, color, religion, national origin, ancestry, or physical handicap.
