




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT TO AMEND THE GOVERNMENT CODE RELATIVE TO
ESTABLISHING THE FUNDING OF A GREYHOUND OWNERS
PRIZE POOL AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE ADMINISTRATION
THEREOF.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 59009(2) of the Government Code is
3 amended to read:

4 "(2) The Commission on a pari-mutuel pool on every
5 dog race which may be withheld by the licensee and the
6 territory for the total contributions made to such pari-
7 mutuel pool shall in no event exceed twenty-five percent
8 (25%) of the amounts contributed thereto, which said
9 maximum commissions shall include the one percent (1%) tax
10 heretofore provided for by Section 59007, the Greyhound
11 Owners Prize Pool established in Section 59001.1 and the
12 additional tax hereafter provided by Section 59010. The
13 one percent (1%) tax provided for by Section 59007, the five
14 percent (5%) Greyhound Owners Prize Pool provided for by
15 Section 59009.1 and the additional tax provided for by
16 Section 59010 shall be deducted from the pari-mutuel pool
17 before the licensee shall have the right to its commission
18 and before the licensee shall receive any money or payments
19 from the pari-mutuel pool."

1 Section 2. Section 59009.1 is added to the Government

2 Code to read:

3 "Section 59009.1. In addition to any other tax, there
4 shall be deducted from the total daily pari-mutuel pool an
5 amount equal to five percent (5%) of all money paid into
6 the pari-mutuel pool to be deposited in the 'Greyhound Owners
7 Prize Fund'. The fund shall be administered by the licensee
8 under the supervision of the Guam Gaming Commission pursuant
9 to rules it adopts pursuant to the Administrative Adjudica-
10 tion Act. Such rules shall require the payment of prizes
11 to owners of greyhounds raced at the track from which the
12 fund is derived. The fund shall not be subjected to any
13 charge, deduction or other diminution of its value. Proceeds
14 shall be distributed to owners within thirty (30) days."

15 Section 3. Section 59009.2 is added to the Government Code
16 to read:

17 "Section 59009.2. Distribution of Greyhound Owners
18 Prize Fund. The Greyhound Owners Prize Fund shall be
19 distributed as follows:

20 (a) If the licensee owns no dogs, then the total amount
21 shall be paid to owners of greyhounds; or

22 (b) If the licensee owns dogs, then one-half (1/2) shall
23 be paid to the licensee and one-half (1/2) shall be paid
24 by the licensee to greyhound dog owners other than the
25 licensee as prize money for sweepstake races."

26 Section 4. A new Section 59009.3 is added to the Government
27 Code to read:

28 "Section 59009.3. Disposition of Greyhounds Owned by
29 Licensee. Within two (2) years from the effective date of
30 this Act, the licensee shall dispose of all greyhounds and
31 subsection (b), Section 59009.2 of the Government Code shall
32 no longer be of force and effect."
