

CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (a) OF SECTION 11102
OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE TO ADD A NON-VOTING MEMBER
TO THE BOARD OF EDUCATION WHO SHALL REPRESENT THE
NON-PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Subsection (a) of Section 11102 of the Government
3 Code is amended to read:

4 "(a) The Board shall consist of eleven (11) elected
55 members, including a student member and four (4) non-voting
6 ex-officio members, including a member of the non-public
7 schools, all citizens of the United States of America and
8 residents of the territory of Guam. The four (4) non-voting
9 members shall consist of: one (1) member selected by the
10 Commanding Officer of the United States Air Force personnel
11 on Guam; one (1) member selected by the Commanding Officer
12 of the United States Navy personnel on Guam; one (1) member
13 appointed by the Governor from those persons nominated by
14 the administrative heads of non-public schools to represent
15 non-public schools; and one (1) member selected by the
16 exclusive bargaining agent of the teachers within the
17 department."
