




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 18 OF PUBLIC LAW 16-44,
RELATIVE TO VOLUNTARY REDUCTION OF WORK WEEK.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 18 of Public Law 16-44 is hereby amended
by adding a new Subsection (d) to read as follows:

"(d) Any department or agency head in any branch
may approve the request of any government of Guam employee
who elects to work less than forty (40) hours per week with
commensurate reduction in pay. An employee who elects to
work less than forty (40) hours per week but not less than
thirty-five (35) hours per week shall continue to receive
full personnel benefits such as, but not limited to, annual
leave, sick leave and retirement benefits as if he is
working for forty (40) hours per week."
