







AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE OVERTIME
OBLIGATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund the
3 sum of Four Hundred Eighty Three Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety
4 Three Dollars (\$483,793) to the Department of Public Safety for
5 payment of outstanding overtime obligations to the personnel of
6 the Department of Public Safety for fiscal year 1981. The
7 appropriation shall be allocated as follows:

8 a) Police Operations - \$384,113
9 b) Fire Operations - \$ 99,680

10 Section 2. The Department of Public Safety shall account in
11 writing to the Speaker of the Legislature no later than March
12 1, 1982 on the expenditures made pursuant to Section 1 of this
13 Act.

Section 4. The sum of Forty Thousand Fifty Three Dollars (\$40,053) (the reduction in appropriation made by Section 3 of this Act) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Administration for the purpose of making payments for prior years personnel obligations incurred between January 1, 1972 to December 31, 1980 by the Department of Public Health and Social Services. Prior to making payment to a person, the Director shall secure from him a release of all claims arising for compensation due him or her for service rendered between January 1, 1972 and December 31, 1980. The Attorney General shall approve as to form each release.

Section 5. The Director of the Department of Administration shall report in writing to the Speaker of the Legislature no later than March 1, 1982 on expenditures made pursuant to Section 4 specifying the amounts paid to claimants and shall certify that all claims paid were in compliance with all legal requirements in effect at the time services were rendered.

 18 amended to read:

 20 eliminated effective October 1, 1982, and that the Director
 21 of Parks and Recreation contract for this service for the
 22 period October 1, 1982 through September 30, 1983."

23 Section 10. The Legislature of Guam may employ and fix the
 24 compensation of special private counsel to institute and prosecute
 25 causes of action and other legal action for and in the name of
 26 the government of Guam and against the United States of America
 27 and other parties to quiet the title of the government of Guam
 28 to the property owned by the United States of America and
 29 employed by the Naval Government of Guam in the administration
 30 of the civil affairs of the inhabitants of Guam.

1 Section 11. There is hereby appropriated from the General
2 Fund to the Legislative Operations Fund the sum of Twenty Two
3 Thousand Dollars (\$22,000) for the operations of the Seventh
4 Guam Youth Congress for the period beginning the third Saturday
5 of October 1981 and ending on the third Saturday of October 1982
6 as follows:

- 7 A. For salaries of a maximum of
8 fifty one (51) Youth Representatives and part-time
9 staffing not to exceed \$18,000
- 10 B. For miscellaneous expenses including,
11 but not limited to supplies, materials,
12 equipment and other contractual services,
13 conferences not to exceed \$ 4,000

14 Section 12. Section 11 of this Act shall take effect upon
15 enactment into law.
