AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE LEGISLATIVE BRANCH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The sums in this Section are appropriated from the General Fund to the Legislative Operations Fund for the payment of the ordinary operating costs of the Sixteenth Guam Legislature.

The figures in the column headed "Item and Subtotal" are the amounts appropriated from the General Fund within each line item. The figures in the "First Session" and "Grand Total" columns are for information only and are not appropriations. The Committee on Rules may transfer amounts among the various items of appropriation.

Section 2. Four Hundred Thirty-Three Thousand Four Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$433,480) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Legislative Agencies Fund to be allocated by the Committee on Rules of the Sixteenth Guam Legislature for the operations of the Suruhanu, Compiler of Laws and Territorial Auditor during calendar year 1982.

Section 3. Any appropriation made to the Sixteenth Guam Legislature for use in the First Session shall continue to be available during the Second Session.

Section 4. The unexpended and unencumbered balances of the appropriations made in: Section 13C of Public Law 14-153, Subsection (b) of Section 2 of Public Law 15-6, as amended, Section 3E of Public Law 15-7, Section 3 of Public Law 15-89, Public Law 15-80, Section 5, Part Six of Public Law 15-48, as amended, Section 12 of Part Six of Public Law 15-48, Section 5 of Part One of Public Law 15-48, Section 6 of Public Law 15-145, Section 23 of Public Law 15-129, Section 6 of Public Law 14-154, Section 15 of Public Law 15-115, Section 5 of Public Law 15-145, Section 10 of Public Law 15-108, Public Law 15-30, Section 1 of Public Law 15-82 and Sections 1 and 3 of Public Law 15-144 are appropriated to the Legislative Operations Fund for the operation of the Sixteenth Guam Legislature.

Section 5. Public Law 16-2 is repealed.
