




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF FIFTY THOUSAND  
DOLLARS (\$50,000) FROM THE TOURIST ATTRACTION  
FUND TO THE GUAM VISITORS BUREAU FOR THE PURPOSE  
OF RECONSTRUCTION OF THE LANCHON ANTIGO IN INARAJAN.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) is  
3 appropriated from the Tourist Attraction Fund to the Guam Visitors  
4 Bureau for the purpose of restoring, expanding and repairing the  
5 Lanchon Antigo in the municipality of Inarajan.
