



AN ACT TO CHANGE THE DATE FOR THE SUBMISSION
OF ANNUAL REPORTS BY HEADS OF DEPARTMENTS AND
INDEPENDENT AGENCIES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 5150 of the Government Code of Guam is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 5150. Annual Report. Each head of a depart-
5 ment, independent agency, board, or commission, shall submit
6 a detailed report by no later than December 31 of each year,
7 unless otherwise provided by law, to the Governor and the
8 Legislature on the operation of the department, independent
9 agency, board, or commission during the fiscal year concluded
10 on the preceding September 30, and projecting the goals and
11 objectives of the department, independent agency, board or
12 commission, as developed for the program budget report. Any
13 department, independent agency, board or commission, may
14 issue such additional reports on its findings and recommenda-
15 tions as its operations require."
