


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT TO ADD A NEW CHAPTER VIII TO TITLE I
OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE RELATIVE TO THE NAME
DESIGNATION OF GOVERNMENT BUILDINGS AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Chapter VIII is added to Title I of the
Government Code to read:

"CHAPTER VIII

Government Buildings

Section 800. The Compiler of Laws shall compile with-
in this Chapter all statutes that name any government of
Guam building, park or property."

Section 2. A new Section 1975 is added to the Government
Code to read:

"Section 1975. Sections 3105 and 4104 of Title 3
of the Guam Code Annotated shall not be applicable to the
elections required to be conducted by Sections 1973 and
1974 of this Code. In lieu of the provisions of those
sections, the Commission shall conduct registration only at
its main office and appoint to each and every polling place
a precinct board consisting of an inspector and two (2)
judges, each of whom shall be paid Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)
for their services."
