




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT TO ADD A NEW CHAPTER XIII-A TO TITLE VIII
OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE TO PROVIDE FOR REMOVAL
FROM OFFICE OF MEMBERS OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new Chapter XIII-A is added to Title VIII of
3 the Government Code to read:

4 "CHAPTER XIII-A

5 Removal From Office of Members
6 of Boards and Commissions

7 Section 6911.1. Unless the provisions of law governing
8 the removal of members from a particular board or commission
9 are to the contrary, the unexcused absences of a member of
10 a board or commission from three (3) consecutive regular
11 meetings of the board or commission shall constitute a cause
12 for removal of the member from the board or commission, and
13 the Governor may thereupon remove such a member from the
14 board or commission. The determination of whether a member's
15 absence is excused or unexcused shall be made by the other
16 members of the same board or commission.

17 Section 6911.2. The chairman of each board or commis-
18 sion shall submit a quarterly report on the attendance of
19 the members of the board or commission to the Governor."
