


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 57181 AND 57183 OF
THE GOVERNMENT CODE RELATIVE TO SPECIFIC
PENALTIES FOR IMPROPER HAZARDOUS WASTE MANAGE-
MENT AND INCLUDING DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE
PERSONNEL AS APPREHENDING OFFICERS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 57181 of the Government Code is amended
3 to read:

4 "Section 57181. Penalties. (a) Any person who
5 violates any solid waste management provisions of this
6 Chapter, or any valid solid waste management rules or
7 regulations promulgated under this Chapter, or who refuses
8 or neglects to comply with any lawful order issued by the
9 Administrator in the carrying out of the provisions of this
10 Chapter shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a petty
11 misdemeanor.

12 (b) Any person who violates any hazardous waste
13 management provisions of this Chapter, or any valid
14 hazardous waste management rules or regulations promulgated
15 under this Chapter, or who refuses or neglects to comply
16 with any lawful order issued by the Administrator in
17 carrying out the provisions of this Chapter shall forfeit
18 and pay the government of Guam a civil penalty of not less
19 than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) per day for each
20 violation for non-compliance.

1 (c) Any person who knowingly stores, collects, trans-
2 ports or disposes of hazardous waste in such a manner as
3 to degrade the environment, create a public nuisance or
4 create a health or safety hazard contrary to any of the
5 provisions of this Chapter, upon conviction, shall be
6 imprisoned not less than six (6) months or be fined not
7 less than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) per day for each
8 violation for non-compliance, or by both."

9 Section 2. Subsection (a) of Section 57183 of the
10 Government Code is amended to read:

11 "(a) 'Apprehending Officers' shall mean any designated
12 individual within the Department of Parks and Recreation,
13 the Department of Agriculture, the Guam Environmental
14 Protection Agency, the Department of Public Health and
15 Social Services, the Department of Public Works and all
16 village commissioners and assistant commissioners, any peace
17 officer in the Department of Public Safety and persons
18 making citizens arrests."
