



AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTIONS 25315 AND 25316 OF
THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO ALCO-
HOLIC BEVERAGE SALES ON ELECTION DAY.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
2 Section 1. Sections 25315 and 25316 of the Government
3 Code of Guam are hereby repealed in their entirety.
