

AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 11417 TO THE GOVERNMENT
CODE RELATIVE TO ESTABLISHING THE JROTC FUND.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new Section 11417 is added to the Government

3 Code to read:

4 "Section 11417. Junior Reserve Officers Training Corps
5 (JROTC) Fund. There is created a 'JROTC Fund' to be main-
6 tained separate and apart from all other funds of the govern-
7 ment. All money received by the government from the U.S.
8 Department of Defense for the operation of the JROTC programs
9 shall be placed in the JROTC Fund. The Director of Education
10 shall be the certifying officer of the fund. The Director
11 shall report annually to the Board of Education, Governor
12 and Legislature on the receipts, expenditures and balances
13 of the fund."

14 Section 2. Section 11951.1 is added to the Government Code
15 to read:

16 "Section 11951.1. The 'Chamorro Language Commission
17 Fund' is created which shall be separate and apart from other
18 funds of the government. The Commission may establish and
19 collect fees pursuant to the Administrative Adjudication Act,
20 for services it provides; may accept donations from any
21 source for the purpose of doing its duties and may enter
22 agreements to do work within the scope of its expertise and
23 receive compensation. All money received by the Commission

1 including appropriations shall be deposited in the Chamorro
2 Language Commission Fund and shall be expended upon order
3 of the Commission. The Chairperson of the Commission shall
4 be the certifying officer for expenditure of the Fund."
