AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 11417 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE RELATIVE TO ESTABLISHING THE JROTC FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Section 11417 is added to the Government

Code to read:

"Section 11417. Junior Reserve Officers Training Corps (JROTC) Fund. There is created a 'JROTC Fund' to be maintained separate and apart from all other funds of the government. All money received by the government from the U.S. Department of Defense for the operation of the JROTC programs shall be placed in the JROTC Fund. The Director of Education shall be the certifying officer of the fund. The Director shall report annually to the Board of Education, Governor and Legislature on the receipts, expenditures and balances of the fund."

Section 2. Section 11951.1 is added to the Government Code to read:

"Section 11951.1. The 'Chamorro Language Commission
Fund' is created which shall be separate and apart from other
funds of the government. The Commission may establish and
collect fees pursuant to the Administrative Adjudication Act,
for services it provides; may accept donations from any
source for the purpose of doing its duties and may enter
agreements to do work within the scope of its expertise and
receive compensation. All money received by the Commission

including appropriations shall be deposited in the Chamorro Language Commission Fund and shall be expended upon order of the Commission. The Chairperson of the Commission shall be the certifying officer for expenditure of the Fund."
