AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 11208 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE RELATIVE TO REQUIRING ECONOMIC EDUCATION IN SCHOOLS ON GUAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Section 11208 is added to the Government

Code to read:

"Section 11208. Economic Education. (a) As used in this section, the term 'economic education' means citizenship competencies needed by the individual for effectively performing his decision-making roles as a consumer, a worker making career choices, and a voter on personal and societal economic issues.

(b) The Board of Education shall adopt regulations and implement programs to insure the teaching of economic education to all pupils in grades 1 through 12 on a minimum time schedule of grades 10 through 12 by the 1983-84 school year, grades 7 through 9 by the 1984-85 school year, grades 4 through 6 by the 1985-86 school year, and grades 1 through 5 by the 1986-87 school year."
