AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 28 OF TITLE 9 OF THE GUAN CODE ANNOTATED TO STRENGTHEN THE LAWS PROHIBITING THE SALE OF OBSCENE MATERIALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. 9 GCA Section 28.40 is amended to read:

"Section 28.40. Definitions. As used in this article:

(a) 'material' means any picture, drawing, photograph,
motion picture, or pictorial representation, or any statue
or other figure, or any mechanical, chemical, or electrical
reproduction, or anything which is or may be used as a means
of communication (other than the written or spoken word).

'Material' includes molds, printing plates and other latent
representational objects.

- (b) 'prurient Interest' means a shameful or morbid interest in nudity, sex, or excretion.
- (c) 'performance' means any physical human bodily activity, whether engaged in alone or with other persons, including but not limited to dancing, acting, simulating, or pantomining which is either public or for commercial gain.
- (d) 'distribute' means to transfer possession of material.
 - (e) Any material or performance is obscene if:
 - (1) the average person, applying contemperary community standards, finds that the material or performance, taken as a whole, appeals to the prurient interest; and

(2) the material or performance depicts or describes in a patently offensive way, sexual conduct, normal or perverted, actual or simulated; and 3 (5) the material or performance, taken as a whole, lacks serious literary, artistic, political, or 5 scientific value. 6 (f) 'sado-masochistic abuse' means flagellation or 7 torture by upon a person as an act of sexual stimulation or 3 gratification. 3 (g) 'sexual conduct' means acts of masturbation, 10 excretory functions, lewd exhibition of the genitals, sado-11 masochistic abuse, bestiality, sexual intercourse or physical 12 contact with a person's clothed or unclothed genitals, pubic 1.5 area, buttocks or the breast or breasts of a female for the 14 purpose of sexual stimulation, gratification or perversion. 15 (h) 'owner' means any person who owns or has legal 16 right to possession of any material." 17 Section 2. 9 GCA Section 28.45 is repealed. 13 Section 3. 9 GCA 28.49 is added to read: 13 "Section 23.49. Every person who knowingly sends or 20 causes to be sent, or who in Guam possesses, prepares, pub-21 lishes, shows, prints or who offers to distribute, distri-22. butes or exhibits to another any obscene material, when such 23 acts or acts are public or for commercial gain, is guilty 24 of a misdemeanor." 25 Section 4. 9 GCA Section 28.50 is repealed and reenacted to 26

"Section 28.51. A person is guilty of a felony of the third degree if he knowingly or recklessly employs or uses a minor under the age of sixteen (16) years to do or assist in doing any of the acts described in Section 28.49 or 28.50 of this Chapter."

Section Sa. Section 28.52 is added to Title 9 of the Guam Code Annotated to read:

"Section 23.52. Use of one's child in obscene acts.

A person is guilty of a felony of the first degree if while having custody or control of any child under the age of sixteen (16) years, he shall knowingly permit that child to be used in or be a party to any material or performance that is obscene."

Section 6. 9 GCA Section 28.55 is repealed and reenacted to read:

"Section 28.55. Defenses. It shall be an affirmative defense in a prosecution under this Article for the defendant to show:

- (1) that the distribution was made to the recipient by a bona-fide school, museum, or public library or by an employee of such organization acting in the course of his employment or of a retail outlet affiliated with and serving the educational purposes of such organization; or
- (2) that the act was done for legitimate scientific on educational purposes."
- Section 7. 9 GCA Section 1.50(f) is added to read:
- "(i) 'person' means any natural person, partnership, firm, association, corporation or other legal entity."
