AN ACT PROVIDING A GROSS RECEIPTS TAX EXEMPTION FOR NON-PROFIT CORPORATIONS ORGANIZED FOR THE FURTHERANCE OF THE CHAMORRO CULTURE AND AUTHO-RIZING GUAM ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY TO GUARANTEE CONSTRUCTION LOANS FOR CERTAIN TOURIST ATTRACTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 19543.03 of the Government Code is amended to read:

Corporations, associations or "Section 19543.03. societies organized and operated exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, or educational purposes, or the preservation of the culture historically indigeneous to Guam."

- Section 2. A new Subsection (t) is added to Section 53553 of the Government Code to read:
  - To negotiate an agreement guaranteeing a loan for the construction of tourist attractions depicting the historical and cultural development of the Chamorro people.
