AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPLACING AND IMPROVING THE WATER PIPING SYSTEMS IN THE SANTA RITA AND AGAT AREAS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Public Utility Agency of Guam the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) for the purpose of replacing and improving the water piping systems in the Santa Rita and Agat areas.

Section 2. The Public Utility Agency of Guam shall act immediately and no later than ten (10) days after enactment of this Act to restore water service to the Santa Rita and Agat areas.

Section 3. The bidding requirements imposed by law shall not be applicable to the purchase of materials and services pursuant to the appropriation made in Section 1 of this Act.

Section 4. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the Governor is authorized to transfer lapsed funds of any department or agency to satisfy the intent of Section 1 of this Act.

Section 5. This Act is an urgency measure.
