





AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$51,885
FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A CANOPY AT BRODIE
MEMORIAL SCHOOL AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The sum of Fifty-One Thousand Eight Hundred
3 Eighty-Five Dollars (\$51,885) is appropriated from the Terri-
4 torial Lottery Fund to the Department of Education for the
5 construction of walkway canopies at Brodie Memorial School.

6 Section 2. Section 3, Part XI (L) and (M) of Public
7 Law 16-44, relative to the Department of Education is hereby

1 amended to read as follows:

21 Section 3. The sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars
22 (\$25,000) is appropriated from the Territorial Lottery Fund to
23 the Department of Public Works for the purpose of resurfacing
24 and repairing the Tennis and Basketball Courts in Dededo and
25 Yigo.

26 Section 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund;
27 Four Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$465,000) to
28 supplement the funding needs of the Public Utility Agency
29 of Guam for the construction and installation of water wells,
30 water lines and chlorination systems on Guam.

1 Section 5. There is appropriated the sum of Forty Thousand
 2 Dollars (\$40,000) from the General Fund to the Public Utility
 3 Agency of Guam for the purpose of installing a water line to the
 4 Taelayag area of Agat.

5 Section 6. (a) Items (H), (I) and (J) of Part II, Section
 6 3 of Public Law 16-44 relative to the Department of Agriculture
 7 are repealed and a new item (H) is added to read:

25 (b) Not less than Thirty-Four Thousand Dollars (\$34,000)
 26 of the appropriation made in Item (H) 2. of Part II, Section 3 of
 27 Public Law 16-44 shall be expended for the prevention of wild-
 28 land fires and enforcement of laws relating to fire prevention.

29 Section 7. The sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000)
 30 is appropriated from the Territorial Lottery Fund to the Depart-
 31 ment of Education for the purpose of constructing two (2)
 32 temporary classrooms at Brodie Memorial School.

1 Section 8. There is appropriated to the Department
2 of Agriculture the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000)
3 from the Territorial Lottery Fund for the purchase of banana
4 seedlings to restock the island with banana plants free from
5 disease and for no other purposes other than the intent of this
6 Section.

7 Section 9. The sum of Twelve Thousand Six Hundred Fifteen
8 Dollars (\$12,615) is appropriated from the Territorial Lottery
9 Fund to the Youth Sports Off-Island Travel Fund for the purpose
10 of sending the Guam Little League All Star Teams to participate
11 in the Far East Regional Tournament. The Seniors and Big League
12 Teams will be held in Taipei, Taiwan from July 24 through July
13 27, 1982, and the Major Little League Team will be held in Osaka,
14 Japan from July 31 through August 5, 1982.

15 Section 10. The sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars
16 (\$100,000) is appropriated from the Territorial Highway Fund to
17 the Department of Public Works for the resurfacing of Route 4
18 between Yona and Camp Witek and Manengon Road.

19 Section 11. The sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000)
20 is appropriated from the General Fund to the Public Utility
21 Agency of Guam to purchase and install water pipelines and to
22 extend water services to residents in Matua, Hautan and Bajo
23 (Quinene Road) in the municipality of Merizo.

24 Section 12. The following sums are appropriated to the
25 Department of Public Works for the following purposes:

26 (a) Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000) is appropriated
27 from the General Fund for the construction of walkway
28 canopies at the LBJ Elementary School in Tamuning;

1 (b) Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$70,000) is appropriated
2 from the Territorial Highway Fund for the upgrading of
3 Casimiru Street in Mongmong to enable school buses to pick
4 up students in the area;

5 (c) Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) is appropriated from
6 the General Fund to supplement an earlier appropriation
7 for the construction of walkway canopies at the J. Q. San
8 Miguel Elementary School in Toto; and

9 (d) Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) is appropriated
10 from the Territorial Lottery Fund for the resurfacing and
11 improvement of the Agana Tennis Courts.

12 Section 13. The sum of Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$70,000)
13 is appropriated from the Territorial Highway Fund to the
14 Department of Public Works for the specific purpose of resurfacing
15 the intersection and the first half mile of the Maina
16 Reservoir Road with an anti-skid overlay.
