AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$51,885 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A CANOPY AT BRODIE MEMORIAL SCHOOL AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The sum of Fifty-One Thousand Eight Hundred Highty-Five Dollars (\$51,885) is appropriated from the Territorial Lottery Fund to the Department of Education for the construction of walkway canopies at Brodie Memorial School.

Section 2. Section 3, Part XI (L) and (M) of Public Law 16-44, relative to the Department of Education is hereby

Section 5. There is appropriated the sum of Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000) from the General Fund to the Public Utility Agency of Guam for the purpose of installing a water line to the Taelayag area of Agat.

Section 6. (a) Items (H), (I) and (J) of Part II, Section 3 of Public Law 16-44 relative to the Department of Agriculture are repealed and a new item (H) is added to read:

(b) Not less than Thirty-Four Thousand Bollars (\$34,000) of the appropriation made in Item (H) 2. of Part II, Section 3 of Public Law 16-44 shall be expended for the prevention of wildland fires and enforcement of laws relating to fire prevention.

Section 7. The sum of Sixty Thousand Bollars (\$60,000) is appropriated from the Territorial Lottery Fund to the Bepartment of Education for the purpose of constructing two (2) temporary classrooms at Brodie Memorial School.

Section 3. There is appropriated to the Department of Agriculture the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) from the Territorial Lottery Fund for the purchase of banana seedlings to restock the island with banana plants free from disease and for no other purposes other than the intent of this Section.

Dollars (\$12,615) is appropriated from the Territorial Lottery
Fund to the Youth Sports Off-Island Travel Fund for the purpose
of sending the Guam Little League All Star Teams to participate
in the Far East Regional Tournament. The Seniors and Big League
Teams will be held in Taipei, Taiwan from July 24 through July
27, 1982, and the Major Little League Team will be held in Osaka,
Japan from July 31 through August 5, 1982.

Section 10. The sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) is appropriated from the Territorial Highway Fund to the Department of Public Works for the resurfacing of Route 4 between Yona and Camp Witek and Manengon Road.

Section 11. The sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Public Utility Agency of Guam to purchase and install water pipelines and to extend water services to residents in Matua, Hautan and Bajo (Quinene Road) in the municipality of Merizo.

Section 12. The following sums are appropriated to the Department of Public Works for the following purposes:

(a) Sixty Thousand Bollars (\$60,000) is appropriated from the General Fund for the construction of walkway canopies at the LEJ Elementary School in Tamuning;

(b) Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$70,000) is appropriated from the Territorial Highway Fund for the upgrading of Casimiru Street in Mongmong to enable school buses to pick up students in the area;

- (c) Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) is appropriated from the General Fund to supplement an earlier appropriation for the construction of walkway canopies at the J. Q. San Miguel Elementary School in Toto; and
- (d) Fifteen Thousand Dollars (315,000) is appropriated from the Territorial Lottery Fund for the resurfacing and improvement of the Agana Tennis Courts.

Section 13. The sum of Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$70,000) is appropriated from the Territorial Highway Fund to the Department of Public Works for the specific purpose of resurfacing the intersection and the first half mile of the Maina Reservoir Road with an anti-skid overlay.
