AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION TO SUPPLEMENT THE OPERATIONS OF GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUTHORITY FOR FISCAL YEAR 1982 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund the sum of Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000) to Guam Memorial Hospital Authority.

Section 2. The appropriation made in Section 1 of this Act is to satisfy the following obligations of the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority:

1.	Government of Guam Retirement Fund	\$1,181,403	
2.	Guam Power Authority	\$	505,528
3.	Public Utility Agency of Guam	\$	79,350
4.	Guam Telephone Authority	\$	46,909

\$1,186,810.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund the sum of One Million One Hundred Fifteen Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1,115,250) to the Department of Public Health and Social Services. The appropriation made in this Section is to pay unpaid Medicaid billings owed to Guam Memorial Hospital Authority and other health providers.

5. Vendors & Other Obligations

Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund the sum of Two Hundred Fifty-Seven Thousand Two Hundred Fifty-Three Dollars (\$257,253) to the Guam Memorial Hospital

Authority for the payment of certain staff promotions and reclassifications of health professionals and nurses for the period ending September 30, 1982. No funds shall be expended from this appropriation until the Civil Service Commission shall have certified in writing to the Bureau of Budget and Management Research that the promotions and reclassifications of health professionals and nurses has been approved. Upon completion of the promotion and reclassification, payment to the affected personnel shall be retroactive to May 1, 1982.

Section 5. Notwithstanding any provisions of law to the contrary, the Governor is authorized to transfer lapsed funds of any department or agency to satisfy the intent of Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of this Act.
