

AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION TO SUPPLEMENT
THE OPERATIONS OF GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL
AUTHORITY FOR FISCAL YEAR 1982 AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the General
3 Fund the sum of Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000) to Guam
4 Memorial Hospital Authority.

5 Section 2. The appropriation made in Section 1 of this
6 Act is to satisfy the following obligations of the Guam Memorial
7 Hospital Authority:

8	1. Government of Guam Retirement Fund	\$1,181,403
9	2. Guam Power Authority	\$ 505,528
10	3. Public Utility Agency of Guam	\$ 79,350
11	4. Guam Telephone Authority	\$ 46,909
12	5. Vendors & Other Obligations	\$1,186,810.

13 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from the General
14 Fund the sum of One Million One Hundred Fifteen Thousand Two
15 Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1,115,250) to the Department of Public
16 Health and Social Services. The appropriation made in this
17 Section is to pay unpaid Medicaid billings owed to Guam Memorial
18 Hospital Authority and other health providers.

19 Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from the General
20 Fund the sum of Two Hundred Fifty-Seven Thousand Two Hundred
21 Fifty-Three Dollars (\$257,253) to the Guam Memorial Hospital

1 Authority for the payment of certain staff promotions and
2 reclassifications of health professionals and nurses for the
3 period ending September 30, 1982. No funds shall be expended
4 from this appropriation until the Civil Service Commission shall
5 have certified in writing to the Bureau of Budget and Management
6 Research that the promotions and reclassifications of health
7 professionals and nurses has been approved. Upon completion of
8 the promotion and reclassification, payment to the affected
9 personnel shall be retroactive to May 1, 1982.

10 Section 5. Notwithstanding any provisions of law to the
11 contrary, the Governor is authorized to transfer lapsed funds
12 of any department or agency to satisfy the intent of Sections 1,
13 2, 3 and 4 of this Act.
