CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT TO AMEND PUBLIC LAW 16-44 RELATIVE
TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY FOR MORE
POLICE OFFICERS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety requires a full-time
2 staff consisting of uniformed personnel to adequately address the
3 delivery of public safety services to residents of the territory
4 of Guam; and

5 WHEREAS, the Legislature is cognizant of the problems being
6 faced by the department; and

7 WHEREAS, the Legislature recognizes that providing adequate
8 safety to residents remains top priority; and

9 WHEREAS, the Legislature, in recognizing this problem, has
10 determined that positive action shall be implemented; now,
11 therefore,

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

1 Section 3. The sum of Four Hundred Ninety-Three Thousand
2 Eighty-Six Dollars (\$493,086) is appropriated from the General
3 Fund to the Department of Public Safety for overtime pay for the
4 period of October 1, 1981 to May 29, 1982.

5 Section 4. The sum of Two Hundred Forty-Eight Thousand
6 Dollars (\$248,000) is appropriated from the General Fund to the
7 Legislative Agencies Fund.

8 Section 5. The sum of Thirty-Eight Thousand Dollars
9 (\$38,000) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department
10 of Public Safety for the purchase of uniforms, supplies and
11 equipment for the Police Reserve Command.

12 Section 6. One Hundred Forty-Four Thousand Dollars
13 (\$144,000) is appropriated from the General Fund to the
14 Legislative Operations Fund of which One Hundred Thousand Dollars
15 (\$100,000) shall be allocated to the Central Administration and
16 Forty-Four Thousand Dollars (\$44,000) shall be allocated to the
Minority.
