AN ACT TO AMEND PUBLIC LAW 16-44 RELATIVE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY FOR MORE POLICE OFFICERS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety requires a full-time staff consisting of uniformed personnel to adequately address the delivery of public safety services to residents of the territory of Guam; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature is cognizant of the problems being faced by the department; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature recognizes that providing adequate safety to residents remains top priority; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature, in recognizing this problem, has determined that positive action shall be implemented; now, therefore,

Section 4. The sum of Two Hundred Forty-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$248,000) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Legislative Agencies Fund.

Section 5. The sum of Thirty-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$38,000) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Safety for the purchase of uniforms, supplies and equipment for the Police Reserve Command.

Section 6. One Hundred Forty-Four Thousand Dollars (\$144,000) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Legislative Operations Fund of which One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) shall be allocated to the Central Administration and Forty-Four Thousand Dollars (\$44,000) shall be allocated to the Minority.
