

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
OPERATION OF THE FIRST SESSION OF THE  
SEVENTEENTH GUAM LEGISLATURE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The sum of Three Million Nine Hundred Ninety-  
3 Six Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-Eight Dollars (\$3,996,388) is  
4 appropriated from the General Fund to the Legislative Operations  
5 Fund for the operation of the First Regular Session of the  
6 Seventeenth Guam Legislature. The funds appropriated herein  
7 shall be allocated by the Committee on Rules and expended in  
8 accordance with the following categories:

- 9 I. (a) For twenty-one (21) Senators,  
10 to include Salaries and Personnel  
11 Benefits, not to exceed \$ 646,640
- 12 (b) For the general operations of the  
13 Legislature, including but not limited  
14 to Staff, Supplies, Miscellaneous and  
15 Contingencies, not to exceed 1,664,748
- 16 II. For the expenses of the Standing Committees  
17 of the Seventeenth Guam Legislature, to include  
18 Personnel Services, Personnel Benefits, Travel  
19 and Transportation, Contractual Services,  
20 Supplies and Materials, Equipment, Miscellaneous  
21 Expenses, not to exceed:
