AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE OPERATION OF THE FIRST SESSION OF THE SEVENTEENTH GUAM LEGISLATURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The sum of Three Million Nine Hundred NinetySix Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-Eight Dollars (\$3,996,388) is
appropriated from the General Fund to the Legislative Operations
Fund for the operation of the First Regular Session of the
Seventeenth Guam Legislature. The funds appropriated herein
shall be allocated by the Committee on Rules and expended in
accordance with the following categories:

- I. (a) For twenty-one (21) Senators,
 to include Salaries and Personnel
 Benefits, not to exceed
 - \$ 646,640
 - (b) For the general operations of the

 Legislature, including but not limited

 to Staff, Supplies, Miscellaneous and

 Contingencies, not to exceed

1,664,748

II. For the expenses of the Standing Committees
of the Seventeenth Guam Legislature, to include
Personnel Services, Personnel Benefits, Travel
and Transportation, Contractual Services,
Supplies and Materials, Equipment, Miscellaneous
Expenses, not to exceed:
