Section 2. Section 14010(c) of the Government Code, as amended, is further amended to read:

- "(c) Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the manager, assistant managers, the manager's secretary, the comptreller and assistant comptroller shall be within the unclassified service of the government of Guam and shall be hired, compensated and employed under the terms and conditions fixed by and at the pleasure of the Board."
- Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund the sum of Thirty-Six Thousand Dollars (\$36,000) to the Guam Health Planning and Development Agency for federal grant-in-aid for the transition period commencing July 1, 1983 and ending September 30, 1983.

Section 4. Public Law 15-141, Section 3 is amended to read:

in Section 1 of this Act as of September 30, 1984 shall revert to the Unappropriated Surplus of the Tourist Attraction Fund."
