

CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



1 Section 2. Section 14010(c) of the Government Code, as amended, is
2 further amended to read:

3 "(c) Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the manager,
4 assistant managers, the manager's secretary, the comptroller and
5 assistant comptroller shall be within the unclassified service of the
6 government of Guam and shall be hired, compensated and employed
7 under the terms and conditions fixed by and at the pleasure of the
8 Board."

9 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund the
10 sum of Thirty-Six Thousand Dollars (\$36,000) to the Guam Health Planning
11 and Development Agency for federal grant-in-aid for the transition period
12 commencing July 1, 1983 and ending September 30, 1983.
