




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT TO AMEND 17 GCA §16113 AND §31110 TO
REQUIRE THAT THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNIVERSITY
OF GUAM AND THE PROVOST OF THE GUAM
COMMUNITY COLLEGE BE APPOINTED BY THE
GOVERNOR AND CONFIRMED BY THE LEGISLATURE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM-

2 Section 1. 17 GCA §16113 is amended to read:

3 "§16113. President of the University.

4 The Board of Regents, by an affirmative vote of five (5)
5 members, shall select, and with the approval of the Governor appoint
6 the President of the University with the advice and consent of the
7 Legislature. The duties, compensation, and qualifications shall be
8 determined by the Board. The President shall be the executive head
9 of the internal operating organizations of the University and shall be
10 responsible for the administration of the academic, business and

1 service activities thereof. The President of the University shall
2 serve as Executive Secretary of the Board, and shall be an ex officio
3 member of the Board."

4 Section 2 17 GCA §31110(a) is amended to read:

5 §31110. Provost.

6 "(a) The Board shall select, and with the approval of the
7 Governor appoint the Provost of the College who shall be its chief
8 executive officer with the advice and consent of the Legislature. The
9 Provost of the College shall serve as the executive officer of the
10 Board, shall be an ex officio member of the Board and shall have full
11 charge and control of the administration and business affairs of the
12 College."

13 Section 3. Section 4(e), Chapter One, of Public Law 16-111 is
14 amended to read:

15 "(e) Except as otherwise prohibited by law and subject to the
16 standards and conditions enumerated by law, the Governor or his
17 official designee may approve transfers of General Fund appropriations
18 as enumerated in Section 5 of Chapter I of the General Appropriation
19 Act of 1983. Transfers authorized pursuant to this provision shall not
20 be effective until five (5) working days after the Governor or his
21 official designee shall have filed with the Guam Legislature a written
22 statement of the conditions under which the transfers were approved
23 together with the justifications for the approval."

24 Section 4. Section 4(l), Chapter I, of Public Law 16-111 as added by
25 Section 12 of Public Law 17-4 is amended to read:

26 "(l) The Governor or his official designee may approve transfers
27 of General Fund appropriations of any line agency to another line
28 agency for the purpose of meeting shortfalls and other purposes
29 specified herein. The Governor or his designee shall transmit a report
30 to the Speaker of the Legislature within ten (10) days of the transfers
31 of such funds.

32 Any lapsed funds generated as a result of the Governor
exercising his transfer authority pursuant to subsections (e) and (l)

are specifically earmarked to fund the following appropriations:

31 Transfers authorized pursuant to this subsection shall not be in con-

1 flict with sections 7, 8, 9, and 10, as amended, of Public Law 17-4, except
2 as herein provided and shall not exceed the total General Fund appropria-
3 tion for the executive branch for 1983 as stated in Public Law 16-111."
