AN ACT TO AMEND 17 GCA \$16113 AND \$31110 TO REQUIRE THAT THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM AND THE PROVOST OF THE GUAM BY TIME APPOINTED COMMUNITY COLLEGE BE COVERNOR AND CONFIRMED BY THE LEGISLATURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUANT-Section 1. .17 GCA \$16113 is amended to read:

#§16113. President of the University.

The Board of Regents, by an affirmative vote of five (5) members, shall select, and with the approval of the Governor appoint the President of the University with the advice and consent of the The duties, compensation, and qualifications shall be The President shall be the executive need determined by the Board. of the internal operating organizations of the University and shall be responsible for the administration of the academic, business and service activities thereof. The President of the University shall serve as Executive Secretary of the Board, and shall be an ex officio

Section 2 17 GCA §31110(a) is amended to read:

\$31170. Provost.

- Governor appoint the Provost of the College who shall be its chief executive officer with the advice and consent of the Legislature. The Provost of the College shall serve as the executive officer of the Board, shall be an ex officio member of the Board and shall have full charge and control of the administration and business affairs of the College."
- Section 3. Section 4(e), Chapter One, of Public Law 16-411 is
 - *(e) Except as otherwise prohibited by law and subject to the standards and conditions enumerated by law, the Governor or his official designee may approve transfers of General Fund appropriations as enumerated in Section 5 of Chapter I of the General Appropriation Act of 1983. Transfers authorized pursuant to this provision shall not be effective until five (5) working days after the Governor or his official designee shall have filed with the Guam Legislature a written statement of the conditions under which the transfers were approved together with the justifications for the approval."
- Section 4. Section 4(1), Chapter 1, of Public Law 16-111 as added by Section 12 of Public Law 17-4 is amended to read:
 - of General Fund appropriations of any line agency to another line agency for the purpose of meeting shortfalls and other purposes specified herein. The Governor or his designee shall transmit a report to the Speaker of the Legislature within ten (10) days of the transfers of such funds.

Any lapsed funds generated as a result of the Governor exercising his transfer authority pursuant to subsections (e) and (i)
