CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

This is to certify that Bill No. 288, "AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE STUDENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM, THE TEACHER TRAINING SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM AND THE NURSES TRAINING PROGRAM AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES", which was returned to the Legislature without the complete approval of the Governor, was, in accordance with the Organic Act of Guam, reconsidered by the Legislature and after such reconsideration, the Legislature did, on the 9th day of September, agree to pass the item veto of Section 8, notwithstanding the objections of the Governor by a vote of two-thirds of all members thereof, to wit: 17 ayes.

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE STUDENT
FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM, THE TEACHER
TRAINING SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM AND THE N'RSSES
TRAINING PROGRAM AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
3 Government of Guam the sum of One Million Nineteen Thousand Six Hundred
4 Thirty-Four Dollars (\$1,019,634) for the Student Financial Assistance Fund
5 established under Section 11802 of the Government Code (codified under 17
6 GCA 15103) and administered by the Board of Regents, University of Guam,
7 to be expended as follows:

8	(a) Professional/Technical Award	\$ 252,811
9	(b) Student Loans	301,667
10	(c) Merit Awards (Guam Residents)	461,716
11	(d) Merit Awards (Northern Marianas Citizens)	3,440
12	(e) Merit Awards (Trust Territory Citizens)	-0-

13 Section 2. Pursuant to Section 11802 of the Government Code, the
14 appropriations made under Section 1 of this Act shall supplement the
15 unexpended balance of Two Hundred Thirty-Nine Thousand Five Hundred
16 Sixty-Three Dollars (\$239,563) in the Student Financial Assistance Fund,
17 including repayments to the fund.

18 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
19 Government of Guam the sum of Three Hundred Seventy-Two Thousand
20 Seven Hundred Eighty-Three Dollars (\$372,783) for the Teacher Training

1 Scholarship Program and the Nurses Training Program at the University of
2 Guam, to be expended as follows:

3 (a) Teacher Training Scholarship Program	\$ 342,783
4 (b) Nurses Training Program	30,000

5 Section 4. The appropriations made under this Act shall be for the
6 period commencing August 1, 1983, and ending July 31, 1984, and shall not
7 be subject to any allotment reserve that could be imposed by the Bureau of
8 Budget and Management Research.

9 Section 5. Subsection (a) of Section 11809 of the Government Code
10 (codified as 17 GCA Section 15201) is amended to read:

11 "(a) The applicant must be a bona fide resident of Guam and a
12 United States citizen or a permanent resident alien and must have
13 achieved an overall grade point average of 3.0 in his high school
14 studies or in his undergraduate studies if he is pursuing an academic
15 graduate degree or an irrevocable letter of acceptance from a pro-
16 fessional school including but not limited to an accredited professional
17 school of medicine, dentistry, law or veterinary medicine."

18 Section 6. Subsection (a) of Section 11814 of the Government Code
19 (codified as 17 GCA 15401) is amended to read:

20 "(a) The applicant must be a bona fide resident of Guam and a
21 United States citizen or a permanent resident alien and must have
22 achieved an overall grade point average of 3.0 in his high school
23 studies or in his undergraduate studies if he is pursuing an academic
24 graduate degree or an irrevocable letter of acceptance from a
25 professional school including but not limited to an accredited
26 professional school of medicine, dentistry, law or veterinary medicine."

27 Section 7. The first paragraph of Subsection (a) of Section 8164 of
28 Chapter 8, Title 4 of the Guam Code Annotated is amended to read:

29 "(a) Members' Contribution Reserve. The amounts contributed
30 by the members shall be credited to this reserve, together with
31 regular interest thereon as herein provided. An individual account
32 shall be maintained for each member, to which shall be credited the
33 amounts of his contributions and interest thereon. Regular interest on
34 such contributions shall be credited annually, as of the close of each

1 year and shall be allowed only on the amount of the accumulated
2 contributions standing to the credit of each member at the close of
3 each year. A statement of account shall be issued to each member,
4 annually, as of the end of each fiscal year, showing the amount of his
5 accumulated contributions plus interest."

6 Section 8. The sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000) is hereby
7 appropriated from the General Fund to the Guam Legislature for the
8 purpose of conducting a power rate audit review of the Guam Power
9 Authority (GPA), provided that no money from this appropriation shall be
10 committed, expended or encumbered until such time as the Board of
11 Directors of the Guam Power Authority approves or proposes to the
12 Governor and the Guam Legislature a power rate schedule other than the
13 one in effect on August 4, 1983.

14 Section 9. In furtherance of the foregoing appropriation and rate
15 audit, the Guam Power Authority shall fully cooperate with the Guam Legis-
16 lature and the rate auditors retained pursuant hereto. The Guam Power
17 Authority shall make all of its documents, records and files available to the
18 Guam Legislature and the rate auditors, and shall provide copies of any
19 documents, records, and files to the Guam Legislature or rate auditors upon
20 request.
