AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE STUDENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM, THE TEACHER TRAINING SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM AND THE N''RSES TRAINING PROGRAM AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Government of Guam the sum of One Million Nineteen Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-Four Dollars (\$1,019,634) for the Student Financial Assistance Fund established under Section 11802 of the Government Code (codified under 17 GCA 15103) and administered by the Board of Regents, University of Guam, to be expended as follows:

(a)	Professional/Technical Award	\$ 252,811
(b)	Student Loans	301,667
(c)	Merit Awards (Guam Residents)	461,716
(d)	Merit Awards (Northern Marianas Citizens)	3,440
(e)	Merit Awards (Trust Territory Citizens)	-0-

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 11802 of the Government Code, the appropriations made under Section 1 of this Act shall supplement the unexpended balance of Two Hundred Thirty-Nine Thousand Five Hundred Sixty-Three Dollars (\$239,563) in the Student Financial Assistance Fund, including repayments to the fund.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Government of Guam the sum of Three Hundred Seventy-Two Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty-Three Dollars (\$372,783) for the Teacher Training

Scholarship Program and the Nurses Training Program at the University of Guam, to be expended as follows:

- (a) Teacher Training Scholarship Program \$ 342,783
- (b) Nurses Training Program 30,000
- Section 4. The appropriations made under this Act shall be for the period commencing August 1, 1983, and ending July 31, 1984, and shall not be subject to any allotment reserve that could be imposed by the Bureau of Budget and Management Research.
- Section 5. Subsection (a) of Section 11809 of the Government Code (codified as 17 GCA Section 15201) is amended to read:
 - "(a) The applicant must be a bona fide resident of Guam and a United States citizen or a permanent resident alien and must have achieved an overall grade point average of 3.0 in his high school studies or in his undergraduate studies if he is pursuing an academic graduate degree or an irrevocable letter of acceptance from a professional school including but not limited to an accredited professional school of medicine, dentistry, law or veterinary medicine."
- Section 6. Subsection (a) of Section 11814 of the Government Code (codified as 17 GCA 15401) is amended to read:
 - "(a) The applicant must be a bona fide resident of Guam and a United States citizen or a permanent resident alien and must have achieved an overall grade point average of 3.0 in his high school studies or in his undergraduate studies if he is pursuing an academic graduate degree or an irrevocable letter of acceptance from a professional school including but not limited to an accredited professional school of medicine, dentistry, law or veterinary medicine."
- Section 7. The first paragraph of Subsection (a) of Section 8164 of Chapter 8, Title 4 of the Guam Code Annotated is amended to read:
 - "(a) Members' Contribution Reserve. The amounts contributed by the members shall be credited to this reserve, together with regular interest thereon as herein provided. An individual account shall be maintained for each member, to which shall be credited the amounts of his contributions and interest thereon. Regular interest on such contributions shall be credited annually, as of the close of each

year and shall be allowed only on the amount of the accumulated contributions standing to the credit of each member at the close of each year. A statement of account shall be issued to each member, annually, as of the end of each fiscal year, showing the amount of his accumulated contributions plus interest."

 Section 8. The sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Guam Legislature for the purpose of conducting a power rate audit review of the Guam Power Authority (GPA), provided that no money from this appropriation shall be committed, expended or encumbered until such time as the Board of Directors of the Guam Power Authority approves or proposes to the Governor and the Guam Legislature a power rate schedule other than the one in effect on August 4, 1983.

Section 9. In furtherance of the foregoing appropriation and rate audit, the Guam Power Authority shall fully cooperate with the Guam Legislature and the rate auditors retained pursuant hereto. The Guam Power Authority shall make all of its documents, records and files available to the Guam Legislature and the rate auditors, and shall provide copies of any documents, records, and files to the Guam Legislature or rate auditors upon request.
