

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 11833 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO THE
BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM,
AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE SELECTION OF THE
STUDENT MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 11833 of the Government Code is hereby amended
3 to read:

4 "Section 11833. Board of Regents. The government, control and
5 operation of the University of Guam is vested in a Board of Regents to
6 be known as the 'Board of Regents of the University of Guam'
7 (hereinafter referred to as the 'Board'). The Board shall be composed
8 of nine (9) members of which eight (8) members, of which at least one
9 (1) member shall be a member of the University of Guam Alumni
10 Association, all citizens of the United States of America and residents
11 of Guam for at least three (3) years, shall be appointed by the

1 Governor with the advice and consent of the Legislature for a term of
2 four (4) years, provided, however, that the members of the existing
3 Board of Regents of the University of Guam shall be deemed appointed
4 to terms which will expire at the end of their current appointments
5 without the necessity of the advice and consent of the Legislature.
6 The remaining Board member shall be a resident of the territory of
7 Guam, a citizen of the United States who is enrolled as a student in
8 the University of Guam. The student member shall be a full Board
9 member with all rights, privileges and responsibilities thereof. To be
10 eligible to serve as a student member of the Board the person shall be
11 a full-time student at the University who has completed one (1) year
12 of study and who is in good standing academically.

13 The student member shall be that person receiving the highest
14 number of votes cast at an election of all students registered at the
15 University of Guam whether full-time or part-time, voting in an
16 election to be held on one day in March of each even numbered year.
17 The election of the student member shall be conducted by the student
18 body senate in accordance with the regulations adopted by the senate
19 and approved by the Board. The Chairperson of the Board shall
20 proclaim the day of the election when one is to be held.

21 Any student member candidate must be nominated by a petition
22 signed by one hundred (100) students attending the University of
23 Guam.

24 The student members shall serve for a term of two (2) years
25 beginning at twelve o'clock noon on the first Monday in May in the
26 year in which he or she is elected. The first election of a student
27 member shall be held in March, 1984.

28 When a student member ceases to be full-time student at the
29 University of Guam he shall be deemed to have vacated his position on
30 the Board of Regents. Any vacancy during the term of a student
31 member shall be filled for the remainder of the term by election by a
32 majority of the student body senate.

1 Section 2. The reorganization of the Department of Labor done in FY
2 '83 is recognized. A transfer of funds up to 15% of the FY '84 budget is
3 authorized within the Department of Labor.
