




CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT TO ADD NEW SECTIONS 42021 AND 42022 TO  
CHAPTER 1, TITLE XXXVIII, GOVERNMENT CODE OF  
GUAM, AND TO AMEND SECTION 42015 OF SAID  
CHAPTER RELATIVE TO THE GUAM ARCHIVES AND  
FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. New Sections 42021 and 42022 are hereby added to Chapter  
1, Title XXXVIII, Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

"Section 42021. Guam Archives. The Guam Archives shall be  
under the general cognizance of the Board which shall have the  
general authority, power and responsibility for the administration and  
operation of the Guam Archives. The Guam Archives shall be the  
official depository of those public records and other papers not in  
current use by the Executive, Judicial and Legislative branches of the  
Government of Guam and have been determined by the Guam Archives  
to have sufficient legal, historical or other value to warrant their  
continued preservation by the Government of Guam.

Section 42022. Disposition of Records upon Termination of  
Functions of Government Organizations. All records of any  
government organization shall, upon the termination of functions of  
that organization, be delivered to the Guam Archives."

Section 2. Section 42015 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby  
amended to read as follows:

"Section 42015. Gifts. The Board shall have authority to accept  
on behalf of, and in the name of, the Government of Guam from any  
government or agency thereof, or any person, advisory services,  
grants-in-aid, gifts, donations of money and other property for the

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benefit of the Library, or the Guam Museum, or the Guam Archives;  
provided that any grants-in-aid, gifts, donations or other form of  
assistance involving an obligation on the part of the Library or the  
Guam Museum or the Guam Archives or the Government of Guam shall  
require the approval of the Governor."
