

AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION 47100.2 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO
MAINTAINING AN AMNESTY BOX AT THE GUAM
INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

- 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
2 Section 1. Section 47100.2 of the Government Code of Guam is
3 repealed.
4 Section 2. Section 2200 of the Government Code (codified as Section
5 6101 of Chapter 6 of Title 3 of Guam Code Annotated) is repealed and
6 reenacted to read:
7 "Section 2200. The Guam Legislature shall be a unicameral body
8 consisting of twenty-one (21) members who are elected at large."
9 Section 3. Section 6102 of Title 3 Guam Code Annotated, added by
10 Section 6 of Public Law 13-152, is repealed.
11 Section 4. Section 2 of Public Law 13-152 is repealed.
