SECTION 47100.2 OF ACT TO REPEAL THE AN OF RELATIVE GOVERNMENT CODE GUAM TO BOX GUAM MAINTAINING AN AMNESTY AT THE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Section 47100.2 of the Government Code of Guam is repealed.

Section 2. Section 2200 of the Government Code (codified as Section 6101 of Chapter 6 of Title 3 of Guam Code Annotated) is repealed and reenacted to read:

"Section 2200. The Guam Legislature shall be a unicameral body consisting of twenty-one (21) members who are elected at large."

Section 3. Section 6102 of Title 3 Guam Code Annotated, added by Section 6 of Public Law 13-152, is repealed.

Section 4. Section 2 of Public Law 13-152 is repealed.
