AN ACT TO ADD NEW SUBSECTIONS (h) AND (i) TO 4 GCA \$4108 RELATIVE TO PROHIBITING THE LUMP SUM PAYMENT OF SICK LEAVE UPON TERMINATION OF EMPLOYMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
Section 1. A new subsection (h) is added to 4 GCA \$4108 to read:

- "(h) Lump Sum Payment Prohibited. Except as provided in Chapter 7 of this Title, no person who leaves the government service for any reason may receive a cash payment for sick leave accrued at the time he leaves such service."
- Section 2. A new subsection (i) is added to 4 GCA \$4108 to read:
- "(i) The provisions of this Section shall apply to all employees including those in the Judicial, Legislative and Executive Branches including those in autonomous entities."
