AN ACT TO REPEAL AND REENACT SUBSECTION  
14004(g) OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE (12 GCA  
§10105(g)) AND TO AMEND SUBSECTIONS (a) AND (b)  
AND TO ADD NEW SUBSECTIONS (d) AND (e) TO  
SECTION 14010 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE (12 GCA  
§10111) RELATIVE TO THE PORT AUTHORITY OF  
GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM  
2 Section 1. Subsection (g) of Section 14004 of the Government Code  
3 (12 GCA §10105(g)) is repealed and reenacted to read:  
4 "(g) Adopt, enforce, amend or repeal harbor and port  
5 regulations for the use and navigation of Apra Harbor and  
6 facilities of the Port Authority of Guam, and to adopt, enforce, amend  
7 or repeal such other orders, regulations and practices that

1 necessary for the administration and discharge of its duties and  
2 powers."

3 Section 2. Subsection (a) of Section 14010 of the Government Code  
4 (12 GCA §10111(a)) is amended to read:

5 "Section 14010 (§10111). Employment. (a) Pursuant to the  
6 provisions of 4 GCA §§4104 and 4105, the Board shall establish, and  
7 may amend, rules and regulations governing selection, promotion,  
8 performance evaluation, demotion, suspension and other disciplinary  
9 action for the employees of the Authority. Such rules and regulations  
10 shall be effective upon approval by the Civil Service Commission before  
11 implementation. Such rules and regulations shall be filed with the  
12 Legislative Secretary."

13 Section 3. Subsection (b) of Section 14010 of the Government Code  
14 (12 GCA §10111(b)) is amended to read:

15 "(b) Employees of the Authority, excluding the directors, shall  
16 be members of the Government of Guam Retirement Fund, subject to  
17 the provisions of Section 4204 of the Government Code (4 GCA §3104)  
18 except that for the purposes of Subsection (a) of said Section,  
19 employees of the Authority shall not be considered employees of a  
20 'public corporation' whereby their membership in the Fund is optional  
21 and membership therein must be specifically requested. The Authority  
22 shall contribute to the Government of Guam Retirement Fund on the  
23 basis of monthly billings as determined by the Board of Trustees of  
24 the Government of Guam Retirement Fund, for the benefit payments  
25 made from such Fund on account of the Authority's employees."

26 Section 4. A new Subsection (d) of Section 14010 of the Government  
27 Code (12 GCA §10111(d)) is added to read:

28 "(d) The Board shall establish, and may amend from time to time,  
29 the compensation rates and classification plan of the employees of the  
30 Authority. Such rates and plan shall be effective upon approval by the  
31 Governor."

1           Section 5. A new Subsection (e) of Section 14010 of the Governme  
2 Code (12 GCA §10111(e)) is added to read:

3           "(e) The Authority shall contribute to the Worker's Compensation  
4 Fund, on the basis of annual billings or as determined by the Worker  
5 Compensation Commission, for the benefit payments made from sta  
6 Fund on account of the Authority's employees for injuries prior to Ju  
7 1, 1985. The Authority shall obtain Worker's Compensation insuran  
8 coverage no later than July 1, 1985."
