

CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR





AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 10001.7 OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO REQUIRE THAT IN
THE CONSTRUCTION OF ALL PUBLIC BUILDINGS,
PARKING LOTS, WALKS AND RECREATIONAL
FACILITIES PROVISION BE MADE FOR THE
PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED, AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:
2 Section 1. Section 10001. 7 of the Government Code is hereby
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "§10001.7. Provisions for Physically Handicapped. All buildings,
5 parking lots, walks and recreational facilities hereafter constructed by
6 or for the government of Guam intended for the use of the general
7 public shall be designed and constructed in such manner as to permit
8 the physically handicapped who are confined to wheel chairs or
9 otherwise of limited mobility ready access to such buildings, parking
10 lots, walks, recreational facilities and to all parts thereof open to the
11 general public. All public buildings, parking lots, walks and
12 recreational facilities now in use by the general public shall be
13 modified, insofar as is possible and practicable, to permit ready access
14 by the physically handicapped, and in leasing buildings for public
15 use, priority shall be given to those structures where access to public
16 areas by the physically handicapped is provided."

1 Section 2. Subsection (a) of Section 6122 of the Government Code,
2 contained in Section 21 of P.L. 17-53, is amended to read:

3 "(a). Pursuant to the terms of Section 6120 of Government Code,
4 except for subsection (a) of that Section, the Governor on behalf of
5 the Government of Guam is authorized to borrow an amount not to
6 exceed Fourteen Million Dollars (\$14,000,000). This Fourteen Million
7 Dollars (\$14,000,00) includes the Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000)
8 authorized to be arranged as a line of credit subject to approval by
9 the Legislature by Resolution according to Section 6120 of the
10 Government Code as found in P.L. 17-4, and not yet drawn down as
11 of the date of passage of this Act by the Legislature and an additional
12 Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000). The amounts, interest rates, and
13 maturity date of the borrowings and renewals and replacements thereof
14 of the entire amount of Fourteen Million Dollars (\$14,000,000)
15 authorized to be borrowed by this Section shall be subject to the
16 approval of the Legislature by Resolution, with all other terms to be
17 determined in the discretion of the Governor through negotiation with
18 the lending institution or institutions involved. This authorization to
19 borrow additional funds shall be utilized first to pay the amounts
20 appropriated in Sections six (6) through twenty (20) of this Act and
21 the balance to pay part of the obligations above with the obligations
22 listed as 1) Due to Government of Guam Retirement System, 2) Due to
23 various vendors, and 3) Litigation claims payable to be paid on a
24 prorated basis."

25 Section 3. Subsection (c) of Section 6122 of the Government Code as
26 found in Section 21 of Public Law 17-53 is amended to read:

27 "(c) The debt of Sixteen Million One Hundred Twenty Thousand
28 (\$16,120,000) owed by the General Fund to the Retirement Fund shall
29 be repaid by no later June 1, 1994 with interest at the average rate of
30 return on investments of the Retirement Fund in the preceding Fiscal
31 Year. Interest and principal shall be paid in quarterly installments
32 commencing October 1, 1984. Interest shall accrue from March 31,
33 1984.

1 Notwithstanding other provisions of law, the Treasurer of Guam is
2 directed to and charged with the duties and responsibilities to ensure
3 that all principal and interest is paid on time preceding all other
4 liabilities and obligations of the Government of Guam other than loans
5 authorized by this Section and existing loans authorized by Section
6 6120 of the Government Code."

7 Section 4. Subsection (f) of Section 6120 of the Government Code,
8 added in Section 22 of Public Law 17-53, is amended to read:

9 "(f) Funds necessary for the repayment of interest and principal
10 on loans authorized by this Section and Section 6122 of the Government
11 Code are appropriated from revenue derived from the tax increase
12 contained in P.L. 17-4, and, to the extent necessary, from other
13 revenues of the Government of Guam and the General Fund. Any
14 excess funds from the tax increases contained in P.L. 17-4 shall be
15 used to retire said debt instruments as additional principal payments
16 and for no other purposes."

17 Section 5. Section 6(f) of Public Law 17-53 is repealed.
