Section 6. The sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund from fines received pursuant to section 19200 of the Government Code (P.L. 17-55) to pay for temporary derainage access for three (3) years in the village of Agat by allowing the Government of Guam to obtain a three-year lease of land for a culvert from the existing roadway to the river behind Lot No. 120-1-NEW-2 in the village of Agat. This lease should contain an option to renew for an additional two-year term with an escalation cost of the lease to be negotiated between private property owners involved and the Government of Guam.

Section 7. The sum of Thirty-Six Thousand Dollars (\$36,000.00) is appropriated from the Tourist Attraction Fund to the Department of Parks and Recreation to replenish the Off-island Sports Eravel Fund.

Section 8. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund the sum of Nine Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$9,500) to compensate the estate of Jose T. Tajalle for his services to the government as Acting Municipal Commissioner of Merizo for the period January 6, 1977 through September 26, 1977.

Section 9. Section 11819 of the Government Code (17 GCA Section 15501) is amended to read:

"Section 11819 (15501). Awards for Citizens of the Region. There are established six (6) annual merit awards to the University of Guam for high school students in the graduated classes of the several public and private high schools in the region. Two awards shall be granted to citizens of the Republic of Palau, two awards shall be granted to citizens of the Republic of the Marshall Islands and two awards shall be granted to citizens of the Federated States of Micronesia. Applicants for such awards shall have completed four (4 years of high school of which at least the last full academic year shall have been in his home country. The students given this award must attain an overall grade point average of 3.0. The Board shall select annually the recipients of the awards, such selection to be based or
