AN ACT TO PROVIDE A COMMON FISCAL YEAR FOR ALL AUTONOMOUS AGENCIES AND INSTRU-MENTALITIES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. Each autonomous agency, Executive Branch instrumentality, and public corporation of the Government of Guam shall maintain its fiscal records on the basis of a fiscal year, which shall terminate on September 30th of each calendar year.

Section 2. The beginning paragraph of Subsectin (b) of 5156 of the Government Code of Guam as amended by P.L. 16-47 is further amended to read as follows:

The Governor shall present the proposed comprehensive "(b) program and financial plan in a message to the Legislature not later than January 31 prior to each fiscal year. If the Governor is in the first year of his first term or an additional non-consecutive term, then the message shall be presented not later than April a of that same The message shall be accompanied by a budget document which year. shall contain the Governor's recommended goels, plans and The budget document shall be furnished each member appropriations. of the Legislature and each department or agency of the Government. The budget document shall contain the following information."

19 Section 3. Section 1 of this act shall become effective with the fiscal 20 year commencing in the 1983 calendar year, which shall terminate on 21 September 30, 1984.
