

CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR



AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR EMERGENCY EXCEPTIONS
TO BID REQUIREMENTS AND TO APPROPRIATE THE
SUM OF TWO MILLION DOLLARS (\$2,000,000) FOR THE
PURPOSE OF DEVELOPING THE MAGAS RIVER.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 6959.5 of the Government Code as enacted in Public
3 Law 16-124 shall take effect immediately. Until creation of the Policy
4 Office, the Governor shall issue any regulations required under that Section
5 and may do so without regard to the Administrative Adjudication Act.

6 Section 2. Section 10001.6 of the Government Code is repealed
7 effective on the date that Section 1 of Public Law 16-124 takes effect.

8 Section 3. To the extent Section 10001.6 of the Government Code is
9 inconsistent with Section 6959.5 of the Government Code as enacted herein,
10 Section 6959.5 shall control.

11 Section 4. The sum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) is appropriated
12 from the General Fund to the Public Utility Agency of Guam for the purpose
13 of developing the Magas River between Talofofu and Bubulao as a source of
14 public water. To the degree available the Agency shall use federal grants
15 and loans made to the Agency, but in the event sufficient federal funds are
16 not available then the money necessary to complete the project shall be
17 expended from the appropriation made in this Section.
