AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE OPERATION OF THE EIGHTEENTH GUAM LEGISLATURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. The sum of Five Million Eight Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$5,850,000), of which Six Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$630,000) is allocated to the Minority, is appropriated from the General Fund to the Legislature Operations Fund for the continuing operation of the Eighteenth Guam Legislature and for the Office of the Suruhanu. The funds for the operation of the Office of the Suruhanu shall be allocated by the Committee on Rules.

Section 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any appropriation made to the Eighteenth Guam Legislature for use up until September 30, 1985, as previously allocated by the Committee on Rules, shall continue to be available until the end of Fiscal Year 1986.

Section 3. The sum of Twenty-eight Thousand Dollars (\$28,000) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Legislature Operations Fund for the operation of the Eleventh Guam Youth Congress.
